### Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct applies to members, not only whilst attending Lakeside Chapter events, but also in their out-of- Chapter activities, in so far as these relate to H.O.G.<sup>®</sup>, Harley-Davidson Dealers, other chapters, or any other situation directly related to the Lakeside Chapter and H.O.G.<sup>®</sup> Action taken against any member exhibiting antisocial behaviour, which is in direct opposition to the ethos of the Chapter, H.O.G.<sup>®</sup> or basic human rights will range from a formal warning to expulsion from the Chapter.

Any member contravening these principles will be invited to a meeting with the Chapter Director and will be expected to attend within 14 days. Failure to attend will lead to expulsion from the Chapter.
